

9TH ANNUAL LOS ANGELES STORYTELLING FESTIVAL PERFORMER/WORKSHOP LEADER APPLICATION

The 9th Annual Los Angeles Storytelling Festival welcomes submissions for the 2010 Festival. The Festival returns on Saturday, November 13, 2010. Workshops will be offered for beginning and experienced storytellers. Storytelling concerts for adults and families run throughout the day.

For consideration, submit a sample of your work, preferably what you would consider performing, on VHS or DVD, and a biography/resume detailing your experience. Indicate the types of stories you tell, such as folk tales, myths, original tales or personal stories. Specify your strengths and preferences, whether performing for adult or family audiences, and workshop offerings for adults or children. The Festival may consider you as a performer, a workshop leader or both.

This year the main performance categories will be personal, traditional and fringe (adult) tales.

Tellers will receive \$100 for each concert in which they are included up to a maximum of two. Workshop leaders will receive \$125 and may also be requested to perform in a concert.

Complete the lower portion of this application and submit it with your work sample/proposal. Include a **self-addressed stamped envelope** if you wish your sample returned, and include a **self-addressed stamped postcard or email address** to confirm that your submission was received. (To encourage a broad representation from the storytelling community, featured tellers in 2009 are not eligible for consideration in 2010.)
